On November 15, 2025, the Peer Power Foundation will present its 9th annual Big River Crossing Race. The half-marathon and 10K are interstate treks across the Mississippi River's longest public pedestrian bridge. This year's event will also feature a 5K plus a fun 1-mile family walk/run from Martyrs Park through the New Tom Lee Park and back.

In partnership with the Memphis Runners Track Club (MRTC), the Peer Power Big River Crossing Race is featured in their Road Race Series. With an estimated 1,000 additional runners incorporated from MRTC, the 2025 race will be our biggest event to date.









Starting at Channel 3 Drive, the half-marathon course takes runners over the Big River Crossing bridge, through the Big River Trail on the Arkansas flood plain and along Dacus Lake. The event also includes a 10K across the bridge with inspiring views of downtown Memphis and the Mississippi River as well as a 5K run and a 1-mile walk/run through the new Tom Lee Park.

The 9th Annual Peer Power Big River Crossing Race supports Peer Power Foundation's mission to inspire and empower student success through a peer-to-peer tutoring and mentoring model. Your sponsorship will create a public connection with this unique event and the transformative work it supports.

Established in 2004, the Peer Power Foundation is a nonprofit organization dedicated to enhancing student success through a peer-to-peer tutoring and mentoring model.

By recruiting and training high-performing college students, known as Success Coaches, Peer Power provides in-classroom support to high school students. This innovative approach has led to significant improvements in academic performance, including an average ACT score increase of 3.2 points among participants and a major increase in Memphis' Workforce Development.




